Job Role Engagement Presentations

PEC received a presentation from Nursing and Midwifery this month led by Amanda McKnight, Executive Director Nursing Services and supported by Directors of Nursing, PECAC members and PEC Ambassadors. The presentation clearly outlined the strategies in place to improve engagement with Nurses and Midwives, including:

- The establishment of a Nursing Engagement Committee at SCGOPHCG, as well as plans to develop a Professional Practice Model that encompasses both SCGH and OPH
- A recent Mental Health Senior Nurse restructure and creation of a centralised MHPHDS Education and Training Service. Four Nursing engagement workshops are also scheduled within MHPHDS
- Finalisation of the Senior Midwifery and Nursing structure and establishment of a Midwifery and Nursing Advisory Committee at WNHS.

WNHS Culture Improvements

Dr Jodi Graham, Executive Director WNHS provided the Committee with an update on strategies being implemented to improve workplace culture at WNHS, including regular Executive walk arounds, written cards, a weekly update and the development of the 'One Team: Our Dream' program, due to launch in October 2020.
