Presentation to the Board

The Board welcomed colleagues from BreastScreen WA who provided an overview of services delivered to the Western Australian Community and the role the Program plays in cancer detection and assessment. In addition, the team provided an update on progresss in the lead up to accreditation in March 2023.

The NMHS Information and Communication Technology ICT Project Director and colleagues were also invited to provide an update on activities being undertaken in partnership with HSS to comply with the mandatory Cyber Security Policy and ensure our vital ICT systems remain secure. They also touched on the staff online Essential Cyber training module, which has been rolled out across the the WA health system.

The Board received an update from the Women and Newborn Service Relocation Project and the work undertaken to ensure the new facility will be contemporary and future-proofed.
