## LIBRARY COLLECTION

The Graylands Library collection is part of the State Library of Western Australia. Resources are selected keeping in mind our main users – clients, family and friends as well as staff.

### BOOKS

The library has an extensive selection of fiction, mental health, self-help and new age books. As well as illustrated books on art, crafts cooking, autobiographies, poetry, the classics, ancient history, everyday science, health, wellbeing, spirituality and much more.

The most popular fiction genres are available in large print or CD formats.

### REFERENCE

The encyclopaedias, dictionaries, atlas, law, health and medical guides are for reference use in the library.

### DVD's

There is an array of action, thriller, comedy and drama DVD's available for loan. MA or R rated movies are not available.

### MAGAZINES

The library has an assortment of magazines for everyone to enjoy. Womens Weekly, Vogue, Mindfood, Gourmet, Wheels, Street Machine, Motorcycles, National Geographic, Popular Science and many more.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

### LOANS

Clients are entitled to borrow a total of 5 items, generally for a period of 1 week only. Items include:

- 1 book only
- 2 DVD's
- 2 magazines

Staff are entitled to borrow a total of 6 items of their choice for a period of 4 weeks.

Pamphlets and brochures are free to all visitors to the library.

### RENEWALS

Most items may be renewed once. This can be done either over the phone or by visiting the library.

### RETURNS

Borrowed items should be returned on or before their due date. It is the responsibility of the borrower to ensure all items are returned in good condition.

Discharged patients must leave all borrowed items at the Nursing Station.

Borrowers will be invoiced for lost or damaged items.

## SERVICES

### INTERLIBRARY LOANS

If you require a book title that is not on the shelf, you may request an inter-library loan.

Interlibrary loans are provided for long stay patients only and permanent staff.

### COMPUTER ACCESS

A computer is available in the library for students to further their studies, correspondence purposes, typing practice, listening to music and playing games.

### PHOTOCOPYING & PRINTING

A photocopier is available for copying A4 and A3 sheets. A limited number of photocopies may be produced free of charge. Standard copyright rules apply.

A laser printer is available for printing A4 correspondence.

### INTERNET ACCESS

There is no internet access for clients on Graylands campus.

Internet searches may be conducted on a request basis for clients and staff.

### NEWSPAPER

The West Australian newspaper is available from Monday to Friday for all visitors to read in the library.
