Residential Care Line Outreach Service

Western Australia has a State-wide, nurse practioner-led outreach service for residential aged care facilities (RACF)

The Residential Care Line Outreach Service (RCLOS) is led by nurse practitioners (NPs), advanced practice registered nurses with the experience, expertise and authority to diagnose and treat people of all ages with a variety of acute or chronic health conditions.

NPs have completed additional university study at Master's level and are the most senior and independent clinical nurses in our healthcare system.

The RCL Outreach Service provides three key functions



Clinical consultation



Care coordination



Education and training

Led by NPs, the service provides

- Expert aged care knowledge and skill
- Comprehensive timely assessment and care planning
- Resident advocacy and additional support for families

Early identification of any change in condition and the resulting escalation for advice are essential to achieve the best outcome for aged care residents.
