





### 1. Canteen reform



- Food environments can impact food choices. Most food and drinks offered and promoted at recreation venues and sporting clubs do not support the community's health.
- Local Governments play a role in developing policies and guidelines to ensure that food provision/lease agreements at council owned facilities align with their Public Health plans.






## 2. Fuel Your Body - Nutrition workshops


