

### **Coordinated care**

- 92% of clients triaged within 10 business days of receiving referral
- Average time from triage to allocation for clients following concussion is 12 days

## **Partnering with stakeholders**

- Host to four occupational therapy honours students exploring return to work outcomes post-ABI
- Active member of the WA ABI Advisory Group
- Contributor to the development of the Clinical Practice Guidelines for concussion through University of Qld
- Presented to 12 WA Health services on SHIU services and ABI rehabilitation

### **Consumer education**

- 155 participants (clients and/ or family/carer) attended an Understanding ABI seminar
- 57 support workers attended ABI training either via SHIU or at their organisation



### **Communicating for safety**

- 93% of clients were provided a summary of their goals and outcomes within one week of discharge
- 95% compliance for mandatory training

### **Client satisfaction**

• 100% of clients surveyed would recommend the service to others in a similar situation.
